Pat Treadway: With higher FC couldn't the fixture spacing be increased and use less fixtures?

MaxLite: Yes

Saul @ McAdams: How long does it need to be tested to make sure is the right application?

MaxLite: Minimum of 100 hours, if the dot stays white then the application is good.

Mary Nathyan: Do you have dimmable HighMax products?

MaxLite: No, HighMax products are not available in dimming.

Jennifer & Peter: Can we retrofit parking lot pole lights?

MaxLite: Sure, MaxLite has been used in thousands of parking lot and roadway fixtures.

Pat Treadway: Is the HighMax only base up or can it be base down? Any effect to longevity?

MaxLite: Good question, base up position is the worst case for CFLs as the heat from the lamp rises and can overheat the ballast above. HighMax was designed for worst case and fairs even better in horizontal and base down applications.
