


To our friends at MaxLite,



Home Builders Blitz

Habitat thanks MaxLite for your contributions during the 2014 Home Builders Blitz and for your presence at the event's opening ceremony in Jacksonville, Florida. MaxLite's fixtures graced more than 200 homes that were built in 34 states from Florida to Hawaii during the blitz. The builds took place in large metropolitan areas and smaller, rural communities.

ReStores

Through a program with various state utility companies, MaxLite donates a certain amount of its products to nonprofit and for-profit organizations. Habitat became a partner with MaxLite in this program in 2012, and by 2014, Habitat ReStores in 20 states were benefiting from MaxLite's donations of LED spiral bulbs, desk lamps, outdoor lighting and an assortment of indoor ceiling fixtures. ReStore customers in more than 115 communities have the opportunity to buy a limited number of these products at a substantially reduced cost.

Heather Sandoval, who manages Habitat for Humanity International's Gifts in Kind program, was invited by MaxLite to attend meetings with utility companies during an Energy Star conference in 2013. Sandoval explained how the MaxLite partnership with Habitat helped advance the companies' shared goals of energy savings and energy efficiency. These meetings gave the utility companies greater confidence in designating funds for the MaxLite/Habitat ReStore

partnership, knowing it will help the companies meet their goals and initiatives.

ReStores help affiliates throughout the country build more Habitat homes, engage more volunteers in Habitat's mission, and protect the environment by recycling and keeping materials out of landfills.

Habitat takes pride in MaxLite's achievements, including the designation as an ENERGY STAR Partner of the Year in 2014. We look forward to continuing to work together to promote energy efficiency and to enhance housing opportunities for low-income families worldwide.
